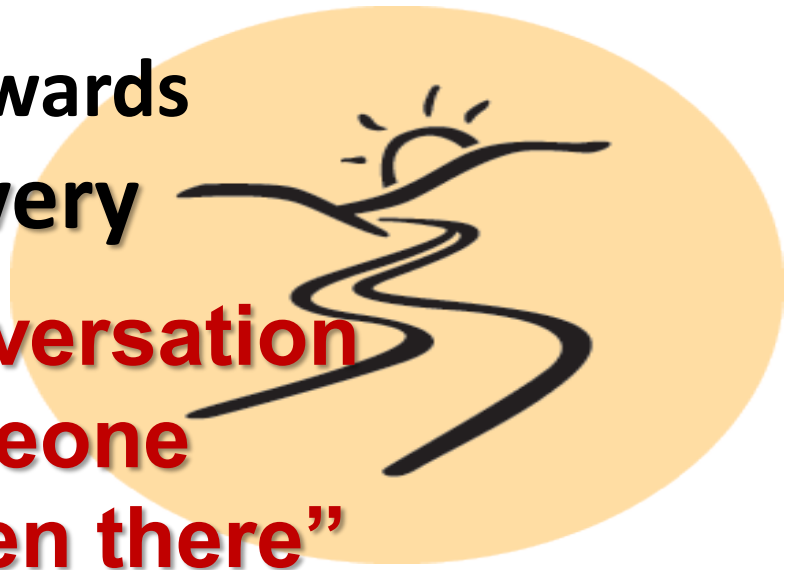


# Find your path towards Gambling Recovery
